COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

- ELIGIBILITY:** This show is open to all ponies/cobs/half-Welsh registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America, Inc., the WPCS, the WPCSC, or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. Only animals registered with the WPCSA will receive points. An animal must be shown under his full registered Welsh number and name. Before an animal is issued a number or enters the ring, the Show Secretary must have a copy of the Welsh Certificate of Registration in the current owner's name and current health document as required by local regulations. If the animal is under one year and not yet registered, submit a copy of dam's Certificate of Registration, the registration number a registered name of the sire and the proposed registration name of entry. Unnamed foals may not be shown. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the Society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on the animal's Certificate of Registration. Leased animals being shown must present a copy of registration listing the lessee.

Person(s) making entry and the eligibility of animal(s) shall be subject to the rules of the WPCSA and the Local Competition.

- STABLING:** ALL Contracts for Stalls & Electric Hook-Ups are to be made through the PennMarydel Show. Contact Show Secretary for more information.
- PAYMENT OF FEES:** ONLY Cash, Checks or Money Orders payable in US Currency will be accepted. A \$30 fee will be assessed for nonnegotiable checks. Fees MUST be paid in full with all paperwork & signatures completed before back numbers will be issued.
- ENTRIES:** Must be postmarked no later than June 1, 2010 to be considered as pre-entry. All exhibitors must have and present to show management a current (within 12 months) and valid Negative Coggins Certificate for each equine brought to the show grounds; Copies of Registration Papers, Coggins and Measurement Cards MUST BE attached to the entry form - ONE animal per form. Incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned.

In addition: Equine originating from outside MD, VA, PA, NJ, DE, WV and DC - MUST HAVE a current (within 30 days) Interstate Health Certificate (CV) signed by a veterinarian prior to entering the state - as required by the Department of Agriculture

- FEES:** Please Note that new entries received and changes made to ANY entry form after the pre-entry deadline will be considered post-entries and charged accordingly.

Double Breeding Classes (<i>includes WPCSA fee</i>):	Pre-Entry - \$35	Post-Entry - \$45
Children's & Performance Classes:	Pre-Entry - \$15	Post-Entry - \$25
Performance Stake Classes:	Pre-Entry - \$20	Post-Entry - \$30

- WPCSA FEE:** Included in cost of Breeding Class - **Ponies ONLY entered** in Performance or Children's classes MUST pay the \$3/animal fee in addition to stated entry fees.
- SCRATCHES:** Entry Fees (minus a \$10 fee per animal) will be refunded by mail - ONLY upon the presentation of a vet's certificate within ten (10) days of close of show.
- CLASS SCHEDULE:** The show will begin promptly at 10 AM on Thursday and at 8 AM on Friday. Classes will be run in numerical order. Show Management reserves the right to divide classes as warranted by entries. (Reference WPCSA Article 111.1, p 14.) **A three (3) minute gate rule will be enforced.**
- HEIGHT & MEASUREMENT:** All animals age six (6) and over must either present a copy of a WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or be measured before being shown in either breed or performance classes. All performance animals under six (6) must present a copy of either a WPCSA or a USEF measurement conducted during the current competition year or be measured. Owners/lessees who are not members of the WPCSA must pay a \$5 fee per measurement. Providing false membership information will invalidate the measurement form and any points earned at the show in addition to incurring a \$25 fine.

Measurement Times: 9 AM to start of Show on Thursday; 7 AM to start of Show on Friday. Please bring - measurement form, copy of registration certificate and animal to concrete pad outside of Secretary's Stand.

- PRIZE MONEY:** As designated below, all prize monies will be awarded with the ribbons at the completion of a class. No monies are awarded in Children's or Equitation classes except as noted in class descriptions.

- JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:** Are individuals who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be retained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1st assume the greater age on that date. Each Junior Exhibitor's full name, age and birth date must be indicated on the Entry Form AND the Permission to Exhibit Signature executed. **Junior exhibitors MUST wear approved protective (ASTM/SEI) headgear at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.**
- ALL MOUNTED RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR APPROVED PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR.**

- 13. **Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched, anywhere on the show grounds, will result in instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.**
- 14. Permanent Restroom and Shower Facilities are on the Grounds. Exhibitors are requested to report any problems to Show Management as soon as possible. Food Service will be available. Trash Receptacles will be located all over the Show Grounds. Exhibitors & Spectators are asked to use them to help keep the facilities clean.
- 15. **Please leave your dogs and other pets at home. If you must bring them, they MUST be on a leash or crated.**
- 16. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or show officials, on the part of the owner/lessee, trainer, rider, or groom, shall disqualify those animals, and the same shall forfeit all fees and be reported to the WPCSA.
- 17. *Every precaution will be taken for the safe keeping of every animal and article upon the grounds. Show management, employees, officials, volunteers or will in no case be responsible for any damage or accident which may occur. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for their own liabilities if incurred, as well as damage or injury to any other person or property, caused by the exhibitor, related individuals, or any of the animals exhibited by them.*
- 18. **Entries are made by Owners, Trainers and Exhibitors with the understanding that they are familiar with the aforementioned rules and regulations.** Should any questions or disputes arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to Show Management, whose decision shall be final..

Division is open to riders 12 years and under. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Riders in this division including the under saddle class may not compete over fences in any other division except Short Stirrup Equitation. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of four (4) fences with eight (8) jumping efforts required. May either trot or canter the entire course. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under-saddle class, pony must be entered and complete a course in at least one over-fence class. Under-saddle class animals shown both ways of ring at a walk, trot and canter.

Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles.

To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk, and leadline walk-trot poles.

WPCSA LEADING REIN (Article 115.1)

Section A, B, C or Half-Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four but not more than eight years of age. Ponies to be judged on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turnout. This is not an equitation class. There are no restrictions for the pony rider.

203. WPCSA LEADING REIN - Six Ribbons & Prize Money

WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY (Article 115.2)

Section A, B, C or half-Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four (4), but not more than 10 years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. Ponies to be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. Ponies to be judged on performance, manners and suitability. Conformation, way of going, and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class. There are no restrictions for the pony or rider.

204. WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY - Six Ribbons & Prize Money

WPCSA WALK (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk both ways of the ring. English or Western attire is acceptable. Rider ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot, walk-trot poles.

205. WPCSA WALK - Six Ribbons

WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. Rider ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, walk-trot poles.

206. WPCSA WALK-TROT - Six Ribbons

WPCSA WALK-TROT POLES (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To be ridden once around over a course of four poles on the ground entirely at a walk or trot/jog. Poles are to be placed at a minimum of four feet off the rail, two on each side of the ring, simulating a hunter course. The poles should be placed far enough away from the entrance gate to provide an adequate sized area to do an opening and closing circle. May be ridden at either a walk or trot/jog. English or Western attire is acceptable. Rider ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, walk-trot.

WPCSA SHOWMANSHIP (Article 115.6)

Judged on presentation and showman's ability to show his/her pony/cob/half-Welsh. 40% of the judging is on neatness and appearance of the showman, pony and tack. 60% will be based on the exhibitor's ability to present his/her pony/cob. Exhibitors will be informed of the judge's choice of pattern to be used, before entering the ring.

From the North: I-95 South - take Exit 77 (RTE 24 N) toward Bel Air. Turn Left - South on RTE 1 (Business). NEXT Light - Turn Right on Tollgate Rd. Showgrounds on Left after Underpass.

From the South: I-95 North - take Exit 74 (RTE 152 N) toward Bel Air. Turn Right - North on RTE 1. Turn Right - Harford Rd (RTE 1 Business). Turn Left on Tollgate RD. Showgrounds on Left after Underpass. **DO NOT TAKE RTE 1 BYPASS.**
