Directions: From the Baltimore Beltway (I-695)

Take I-695 to Dulaney Valley Road (MD-146), Exit 27B. Take Dulaney Valley north 4.1 miles. After the Loch Raven Reservoir Bridge bridge, bear left onto Jarrettsville Pike (also MD-146). You will go through the town of Jacksonville (4.2 miles). Turn right on Pocock Rd. approximately 5 miles north of the stop light in Jacksonville, and the ElkrIDGE Harford Hunt Club will be on your immediate left.

RULES & REGULATIONS
In Addition to the General Rules of the WPCSA

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** This show is open to ponies registered with and foals eligible for registration with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of America. Person making entry and the eligibility of the animal shall be subject to the rules of the WPCSA and the Local Competition.
2. **Payment of Fees:** Only Cash, Checks or Money Orders payable in U.S. Currency will be accepted. A \$25.00 fee will be assessed for Non-Negotiable Checks. Fees must be paid in full with paperwork and signatures complete **before numbers will be issued.**
3. **Entries: Must be postmarked no later than May 6, 2009** to be accepted. **NO POST ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** All entries require Negative Coggins taken within one year of the date of the show. Copy of Pony Registration Papers and Measurement Cards **MUST BE** attached to the entry form. **Incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned.**
4. **Fees:**

Double Judged Breeding, with WPCSA fee	\$30.00
Performance Classes	\$10.00
WPCSA recording fee, performance only	\$ 3.00
5. **Number Fee:** The number you are given will be your number for all the Shows in the 2009 PC Silver Series. You may turn in your number at the end of the show, where it will be put in your folder awaiting the next show. If you lose your number, you will be charged a fee of \$10.00.
6. **Scratches:** Entry Fees (minus a \$10.00 fee per animal) will be refunded by mail **ONLY UPON THE PRESENTATION OF A VET'S CERTIFICATE AND NOTIFICATION TO THE SHOW SECRETARY** before the start of the show.
7. **Prize Money:** The prize money for this show totals \$240.00. \$10 will be given for each judge in the following divisions: Champions of Section A and Section B Fillies, Colts, Stallions, Mares and Geldings; Grand Champions of Sections C/D and Half Welsh.
8. **Ribbons:** No ribbons will be given. All classes will be placed 1st to 4th. Look for results to be available on line after the show.
9. **Height and Measurement:** All entries age 6 and over must present a measurement Card from the USEF or WPCSA or be measured before getting your numbers to show. All ponies in performance classes must have a measurement card. Measurement will Take place at 8:00am on the day of the show.

Coggins/Rhino: A negative Coggins test certificate, or copy thereof, within one year of the show is **required**. A vaccine for Equine Rhinopneumonitis within 90 days of the show is **strongly recommended**.

- 10. Dogs:** Please leave your dogs and other pets at home. If they come, they **Must be on a leash or crated**.
- 11. Bathing Ponies:** This facility has no place for you to bathe your ponies. A bath will not be required, but a good brushing will.
- 12. Motorized Vehicles:** There will be no motorized vehicles such as golf carts or scooters allowed on the grounds.
- 13. Protective Head Gear:** Protective head gear must be worn by all mounted riders at all times.
- 14. Classes may be divided** at show management's discretion if entries warrant
- 15. Food:** You will need to bring your food and drinks.
- 16. Stabling:** Please note that there is **NO** stabling available for the show.
- 17. Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.**
- 18. Every precaution will be taken for the safe keeping of every animal and article upon the grounds. Show management, employees, officials, volunteers or Heavenly Waters Equestrian Center will in no case be responsible for any damage or accident which may occur. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for their own liabilities if incurred, as well as damage or injury to any other person or property, caused by the exhibitor or any of the animals exhibited by him/her.**

10 Minutes Schooling for Short Stirrup Only

WPCSA Short Stirrup Hunter: Division is open to riders 12 years and under. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Riders in this division, including the under saddle class, may not compete over fences in any other division except short Stirrup equitation. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. May either trot or canter the entire course. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under-saddle class, pony must be entered and complete a course in at least one over-fence class. Under-saddle class animals are shown both ways of ring at a walk, trot and canter

WPCSA Adult Low Hunter: Division is open to adult riders mounted on ponies/cobs/half Welsh. Riders in this division, including the under saddle class may not compete in any other over fence class for the entire 2009 show season. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. May either trot or canter the entire course.

Animals 13.2hh and under will jump 2'0", animals over 13.2hh shall jump 2'6". Under saddle (u/s): To be eligible, pony must have shown in and completed an over fences class. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be required to hand gallop one way of the ring but no more than eight animals at one time.

Working Classes are judged 100% on performance.
